- Impacting professional brand with colleagues and career
- Impacting credibility with prospects:
 - If they can't hear you, they can't trust you and won't buy from you.
- Professional etiquette matters on remote calls as well



The journey of my video setup

- Far left is typically what we see now and even on the news
- This is their chance to shine in their industry, as a thought leader and industry commentator. But they've instantly killed their impact and lost an opportunity
- I now use the far-right setup:





Avoiding Distracting backgrounds

- Clutter
- Home-life
- Clothes in shot





Turn your video on!

- It creates a human connection
- It builds trust with others on the call
- We can read body language
 - Non-verbal and verbal communication
- There's nowhere to hide for all involved
- If you hate seeing yourself on camera, this will help with self-image issues like it did for me



Build your own look and feel in your working space

- Personalise your space
 - Add objects of personal interest like hobbies e.g. Cameras
 - Show qualifications e.g. degrees
 - Add background lighting (practical lights)
 - Add some nature Fake plants from Amazon
 - Pictures of the wall of your local area



Treat video calls like a video production

- Lights
- Camera
- Audio









Lighting

You can go simple with a ring light or have fun with advanced lights.
But have something. Webcams aren't professional cameras and need a lot of light to work well.



Camera

 You can use legendary webcams like the Logitech C920s or even use your phone with apps like Irium to connect your phone camera to Zoom/Teams



Audio

• One of the biggest issues. Use something simple like your smartphone headphones with a microphone. Wireless headphones look best personally or a mic on an arm like the Blue Yeti. I'll show my Blue Yeti in the shot.



Experiment

- Experiment, have fun and make the effort to stand out from those around you.
- It will get noticed.
